

Accessing Legal Help

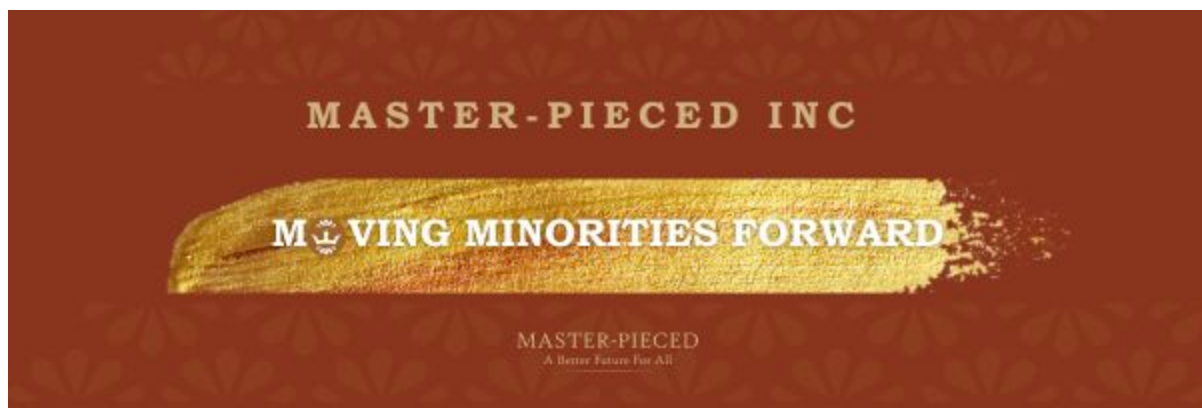
Accessing legal help as an immigrant can be crucial for navigating the complexities of immigration law and ensuring your rights are protected. Here are some steps you can take:

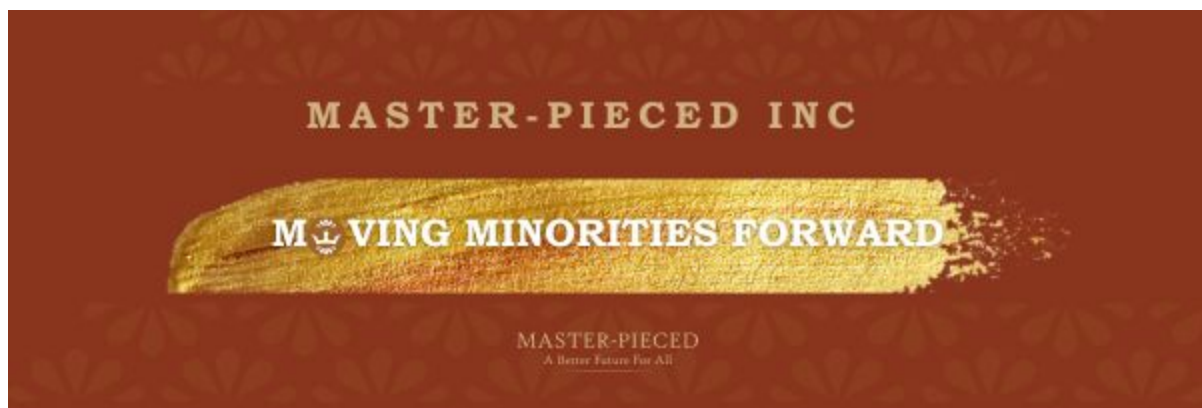
